

One Newport Public Services Board (PSB) - Summary of Business: 12 December 2017

City Centre

Representatives of the Newport Now Business Improvement District (BID) attended the meeting to discuss car parking, vacant units, rough sleeping and antisocial behaviour in the city centre.

Partnership working between the PSB and Newport BID is important for ensuring a safe, well-managed city centre.

Joint action is co-ordinated through One Newport's Safer City Centre Group, which includes BID representation.

A new City Centre Masterplan is being developed and consulted upon.

Single Integrated Plan 2017-18 progress

Lead officers for the three key themes in the Single Integrated Plan reported on Q2 performance. The themes are Economy & Skills, Health & Wellbeing, and Safe & Cohesive Communities. Performance dashboards are available on [One Newport website](#).

The Board was also updated on the range of action underway in Pill. A residents' survey undertaken in October 2017 shows an increase in public confidence in the action being taken by the Police and partners.

City Deal

The Board received a presentation on the Cardiff Capital Region City Deal, which is expected to create 25,000 jobs in the region.

In Newport, the City Deal has already established the National Cyber Security Academy at the University of South Wales and the National Software Academy with Cardiff University, and is creating a compound semi-conductor foundry with 2,000 technology jobs at the former LG site.

Partnership Evaluation

The Board reviewed progress against its Partnership Evaluation Improvement Plan. Considerable progress has been made against the plan in the last 12 months.
